Dear A.S.C.,

It has been a rough start, however I am confident that things are rapidly moving in the right direction. I have spent a lot of time studying the Wyo-Braska WebRules, Privacy Policy, the Twelve Service Concepts and the Twelve Traditions of NA all in an effort to bring myself up to speed on my responsibilities. As always, more will be revealed. The e-mail account, help@wyo-braskana.org was just under 97% full, much of which dated back to 2004. As outlined in the privacy policy I deleted most of what had accumulated with the exception of current requests that I responded to. I also kept the calls for speakers and sent them e-mails to check if they are still current. The account contact phone number is listed as, 307-432-0039. Also, all of the domain contacts are listed as Richard M. Please let me know if any or all of this needs updated. As for the financials, the domain name is set to auto renew on September 3, 2011 at \$11.99 per year. The hosting account is set to auto renew on September 20, 2011. The monthly charge is \$8.99 and unless there is a yearly rate the total cost will be \$107.88. Moving on to the technical side. To start things off, I have sampled the colors from "IT WORKS: HOW AND WHY" and matched the website as best as I could. I also created a new NA logo and WBASC

banner with matching colors. On the Home page announcements, I updated this years Unity Davs with a download for the flyer, and the July Area meeting. On the ASC page, where it says "For links to the Minutes, Guidelines & Values please see the Area Archives page and for a printable meeting list check out the Groups & Meetings page." I made the words "Area Archives" and "Groups & Meetings" into clickable links to their respective pages. I also updated the scrolling marquee to reflect the July Area meeting. The next thing to update on this page is the list of current serving officers. Help with this list would be appreciated. On the Groups & Meetings page I have added the Alliance, NE. Just For Today group. Live From Laramie only meets on Wednesday and Saturday now, so that is reflected, and the Clean and Free groups Friday meeting start time at 6:00 pm is also updated. The downloadable pdf matches these changes. I would appreciate it if someone would look over the meeting list to catch potential errors or omissions. Thank you. Also, John K. has requested that the Burns meeting be added to the list. I have not touched the Archives page as of yet, however, I feel it could use some tidying up. On the Links & Events page I updated Unity Days and the Picnic in the Park. Both with downloadable flyers. On the Unity Days page, I updated, what else but Unity Days. Also with a downloadable flyer and the addition of an interactive Google map. The URMRCNA page has also been untouched. We have received an e-mail requesting information for the next location and dates. The Contact page has also been unchanged. The Clean Time Calculator was non-functional so I deleted the entire page until I can get it reprogrammed. As for the code base (HTML) of the website, I have been stripping extraneous code that was in it. This will help with quicker page loading. Also, there are several accessibility issues. I will be adding image descriptions, alternate text tags and tool tips to each hyperlink. This will make the site more user friendly to visitors using adaptive technologies such as screen readers, Braille read outs and so on. Much of the code on the bottom of each page had become garbled rendering the hit counters and a lot of the bottom navigation broken. This has all been fixed. Our search engine rankings are very low. Some pages are ranked zero out of ten and the home page is the highest ranked at three out of ten. It will help to have targeted keywords in the metadata of each page that is relevant to the content of each page. I will be working on other methods of search engine optimization as well. In closing, the hit counters on each page give vague information about traffic to the website. The idea of using Google Analytics was brought up, so I went ahead and started tracking the site. It does not collect any personal information about users past what browser and operating system they use to get there. It does give a great deal more detail about what pages have been hit, how many times and how many absolute unique visitors there have been. There has been a lot accomplished, however, much remains. Dear A.S.C..

As discussed last month, there have been some major changes with our web site. I discontinued the Website Tonight account and ordered a standard hosting account through the same company, Go Daddy. We also got a discount on our domain name renewal with this purchase.

We received e-mail from four people in August. One was seeking information about detox clinics in Cheyenne. One was requesting meeting information in Laramie. Andy E. from the URMR requested the addition of the convention in May 2012. The last was inquiring if we had a newsletter. There have also been a couple people asking about a newsletter in person.

Visitor Statistics and Trending

In the month of August we had a total of 130 visits from 94 Absolute Unique Visitors. This included 121 visits from all over the U.S, 2 from the Ukraine, 2 from an unknown source, 1 from Canada, 1 from Estonia, 1 from the Netherlands, 1 from Kenya and 1 from Spain. There were 14 sources of traffic, 57 were direct visits by using our url. The rest were referrals from Google and other websites such as: na.org, urmrna.org, wyomingna.org, etc. A total of 24 keywords were used by visitors to get to our site. I won't bore you with the entire list, but the most used were: NA Cheyenne Wyoming, Wyobraska and NA meetings in Cheyenne Wyoming. There were a total of 262 page views and are broken down in the following table:

Financial

The new hosting cost is \$5.19 monthly which is \$62.28 a year. That is a savings of \$45.60 yearly. The hosting is set to auto renew on August 20, 2012.

We were given a discount on our domain name renewal with the purchase of the hosting account. We were charged \$2.17 instead of the normal \$11.99. The domain name is set to auto renew on September 3, 2012 and will return to the normal yearly cost of \$11.99.

Technical

The new hosting account was setup and ready to go on August 21, 2011. Over the previous week I had prepared the database, new graphic header and the general layout of the site so all I had to do was transfer those to the hosting account.

The first page to go back up was the meeting list, as I felt it was the most important item to get back up. Over the next ten days, ten more pages were created and uploaded. In no particular order, those pages are as follows: Home, New to NA, What is NA?, What to Expect, Events, WBASC Archive, Clean Time Calculator, Recovery Literature, Links and the Contact Us page.

The Home page contains introductory paragraphs about the Wyo-Braska Area and a map.

New to NA, is a new addition to the site and provides a list of suggestions for the newcomer as well as a list of recommended reading.

What is NA?, is the reading taken from the Basic Text, 6th ed., pg 9.

Another new page to the site is, What to Expect. It is a generalized list of what happens at NA meetings, has some suggested behavior and a link to, An Introduction to Narcotics Anonymous Meetings pdf. The Events page has a calendar style layout with a monthly and weekly view available. All events are color coded by category, i.e. World, Region and so forth, and can be filtered to show only a specific category by clicking the color coded buttons at the top of the calendar. Clicking on the event in the calendar will bring up the details including any possible link to an affiliated website, and if there is a physical address provided, there will be a link to a map.

I created a table layout for the WBASC Archive with the months in the columns and years in the rows. The Clean Time Calculator has drop down lists that contain values for selecting day, month and year in order to calculate clean time. Once the clean date has been selected and submitted, the results return in the form of days, months and years clean with the display of the appropriate colored key tag. At the bottom of the page is a guide to how clean time is counted and what color key tag goes with it. On the Recovery Literature page is a layout of the currently approved NAWS literature similar in style to the second page in the Basic Text. In keeping with the NAWS guidelines on creating a NA website and abiding by the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust, all literature contained are direct links to na.org pdf's.

The Links page is categorized by World, Zonal, Region and Area. At the bottom of the page is a form that visitors can use to submit link suggestions to the website. All suggestions go into a queue for review to make sure the sites adhere to NAWS and Wyo-Braska guidelines. At that time they will be approved and published or discarded.

The Contact Us page is pretty standard. It provides the Area P.O. Box, number to the helpline and a form for contact.

A header graphic, left hand navigation, last updated time, hit counter, methods of contact and an upcoming events list that is synchronized with the calendar that displays the next four events are located on every page of the website.

The circular NA logo was used to create a small image known as a favicon, or favorite icon. Favicons are displayed in the bookmarks list and on the browser tab for quick identification purposes.

The recent changes allow for per page keywords and descriptions that are useful in Search Engine Optimization. This information is not displayed on the site, but is used by search engines to display what a page is about in search results. A xml sitemap has been submitted to the major search engines and every time new content is added to the site it will be crawled by the search engines for further indexing purposes.

In closing, I would like to tell you that this is by far the most meaningful and rewarding project I have ever been involved with. Thank you all for allowing me to serve in this capacity. In loving service,
