





The SPAD group of NA began with its first meeting on Tuesday, July 23rd, 2019. Our group meets on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings at 5:15 PM at 1904 E. 15th Street in Chevenne at the Alano Club in the NA Room. We are registered with NA World Services.

Each meeting we will be reading the daily entry in our new SPAD book once it is approved and published. In the meantime, we are reading one of he 48 approved drafts, 12 each on Unity, Acceptance, Surrender and Love. 

- One Flag per group (no larger than a regular size pillow case)
- Groups must be active in the Wyo-Braska Area to play
- Only one flag may be awarded per visit
- Each group will accumulate points based on each time they take the flag of another group who is not in the same town (ie: Scotts Bluff, Cheyenne both have multiple groups per town. It must be an out of town meeting)
- When a flag is taken, meeting opener of the group can sign the scorecard of the group who is taking the flag.
- Meeting to take a flag must be a regular meeting. No area, business meetings or special events.
- If two groups show up to get a flag from the same meeting, the first to ask for the flag will get it
- To capture a flag, you must have two or more addicts from the same home group
- Game will be started August 1st, and End July 31st of each year
- The group with the most points at the end of the year, wins a potluck barbecue in their hometown hosted by the other groups who participated
- If addicts travel out of town for a flag and another group has already taken the flag, don't worry, your reward is a great "out of town" meeting
