The Aug 7, 2019 the literature books was ordered for Big Mike to take into the jail. The order total was \$243.50. I need to request a check be written to Ray as he covered \$226.02 of the order. \$17.50 of the order along with \$55.85 from the OLT order on the same date was what I had on hand. In Short of the confusion, The Aug 7<sup>th</sup> order total was \$299.35. With what I had in stock and not having a debit card at the time Ray covered \$ 226.02, OLT ordered \$55.85, and with the literature stock of a \$-17.50.

Next order which has been taken out of the account and not yet collected as it was placed Sep 4, 2019 and said it started the shipping process Sep 6, 2019. Amount of this order was \$372.96. Which ill collect \$119.60 from OLT and \$253.55 from Clean & Free, for a total of \$373.15 collected. That's amazing how close the rounded is to the actual amount.

The Basic Group of NA began with its first meeting on Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Our group meets on Monday and Thursday evenings at 5:30 PM at 1904 E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street in Cheyenne at the Alano Club in the NA Room. We are registered with NA World Services and our Group Code number is G00362471.

Each meeting we read the daily reading for that day from our ***Just For Today*** book. To get started the group spend \$62.00 on supplies: i.e., a Group Starter Kit, Group Reading Cards, plus one ***Just For Today*** book, the hardcover “special edition”. Our group also, along with the ATOS group, split half the costs of the Literature Rack and the NA Posters for the NA meeting room in our meeting location and paid for one registration for the Wyo-Braska Area Unity Day celebration at the cost of \$15, bringing the group’s total start-up expenses at \$77.00.

We have met 42 times since the group began, collecting \$395.50 in 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition and paying \$328.50 in rent (*our rent is 80% of the 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition collection for each meeting*), meaning we still have a short way to go to “break-even”. We have had 251 members total in attendance for our 45 meetings which is an average of just under 6 members per meeting. Our group obviously needs support, which is what we are asking now from our Area.

We are, as mentioned, a Group which meets twice per week, on Monday and Thursday evening at 5:30 PM and is a very good meeting which will do very well with the support of its Area. We look forward to seeing you all at the Basic Group of NA.

So to sum-up, our needs are that of support from our friends in and around the Wyo-Braska Area so we ask you to join us and help to get our new meeting established. The ATOS group of NA began with its first meeting on Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Our group meets on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday mornings at 8:30 AM at 1904 E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street in Cheyenne at the Alano Club in the NA Room. We are registered with NA World Services and our Group Code number is G00364408.

Each meeting we study the first, second or third Step of Narcotics Anonymous from either our *Basic Text*, the *It Works How & Why* or the *Narcotics Anonymous Step Working Guides* on a continuous and rotating basis. The format was designed for newcomers and experienced members alike. To get started the group spend \$178.00 on supplies: i.e., a Group Starter Kit, Group Reading Cards, one each **Basic Text**, **Step Working Guides** and **It Works How & Why**, six copies each of the first three steps from the afore mentioned books, along with half the costs of the Literature Rack and the NA Posters for the NA meeting room in our meeting location.

We have met 45 times since the group began, collecting \$232.21 in 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition and paying \$172.64 in rent (*our rent is 80% of the 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition collection for each meeting*), meaning we still have quite a ways to go to "break-even". We have had 151 members total in attendance for our 45 meetings which is an average of 3.35 members per meeting. Our group obviously needs support, which is what we are asking now from our Area.

We are, as mentioned, a Group which meets three times per week, on the weekends and in the morning, and is a very good meeting which will do very well with the support of it's Area. We look forward to seeing you all at the ATOS Group on Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings. Many times, we have donuts brought-in by group members to share with each other.

So to sum-up, our needs are that of support from our friends in and around the Wyo-Braska Area so we ask you to join us and help to get our new meeting established. 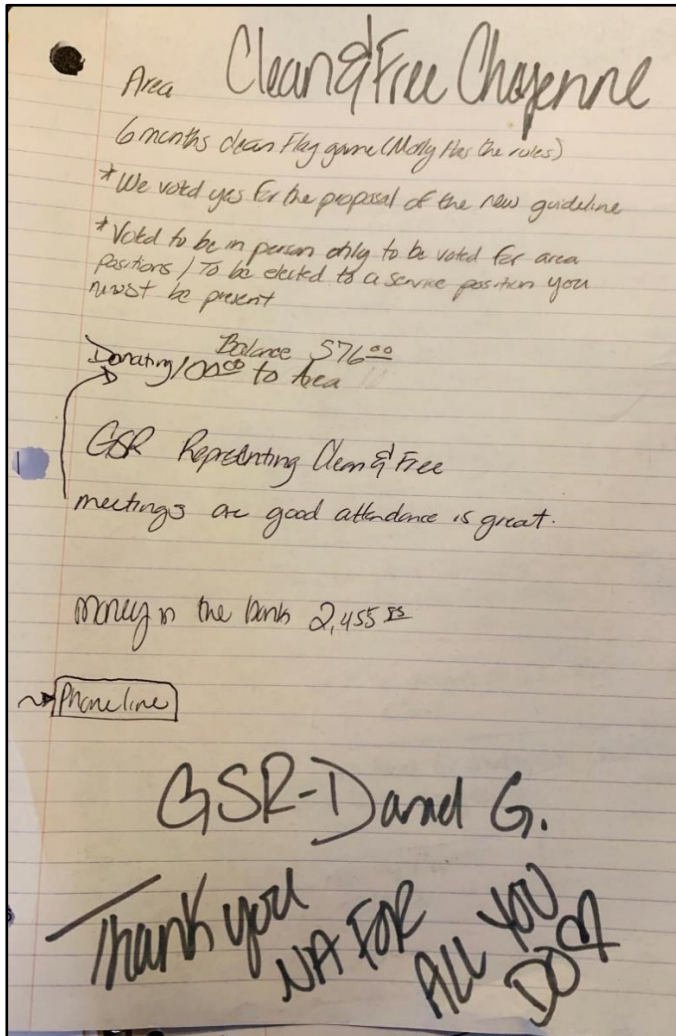
